


# What is affordable housing?

- Vocabulary: affordable?
  Workforce? Accessible?
  Attainable?
- Measurements:
  - Those paying more than 30% of gross income are "costburdened"
  - "Area Median Income" (AMI) used to create affordability bands in each community

# What can be done?


Steps to address affordable housing demand and supply; building capacity in the affordable housing sector

### Helping lower income households

- Income and income support
- Emergency assistance
- Housing Choice vouchers
- Source of income discrimination, state laws



# Increasing housing supply

- Providing land
- Providing capital/subsidies
- Preserving existing resources
- Expanding opportunities (zoning and density)



# Advocacy and capacity building

- Advocacy at federal, state and local levels
- Increase capacity within housing nonprofits
- Increase collaboration between key housing sector actors
